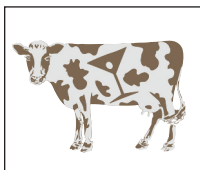

VERMONT WHITE

100% Milk Sugar Vodka

(USA; Vermont Spirits Co., St. Johnsbury, VT)

Impeccably clear, translucent, and pure in appearance. In the first nosings I detect subtle notes of chalk and paper; additional aeration time of six minutes adds only soft whispers of cream, powdered milk, and refined sugar. The palate entry is bittersweet and tightly structured – there's no flab or fat in the opening taste profile; by midpalate, the bittersweet aspect develops into a fully sweet, honey-like presence that underlies the other more superficial flavors of honey and powdered milk. Concludes pleasingly sweet and silky. Excellent distilling job here.
